## HOW FOLLOWING BABY BACK HOME WORKS

FBBH is a free service designed to help babies and their families by building the family's skill and confidence in providing a safe, nurturing home for their baby.

### SERVICES PROVIDED:

-  Free of charge to the family
-  Continued as long as needed up to age 3
-  Arranged to meet the family's schedule
-  Offered to families taking their baby home from an Arkansas NICU. Services are available in Northeast, Northwest, River Valley, Central, South and Southwest Arkansas
-  Provided by home visitors who are Registered Nurses and licensed Social Workers
-  Closely coordinated with the child's primary care provider and/or specialty clinics to assure continuity of care

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
