FBBH is designed to help infants and their families by building the family's skill and confidence in providing a safe, nurturing home for their infant.

- ▶ Free of charge to the family
- Continued as long as needed, up to age 3
- Arranged to meet the family's schedule
- Home visiting services provided by Registered Nurses and Licensed Social Workers
- Offered to families taking their infant home from an Arkansas NICU. Services available in Northeast*, Northwest*, River Valley*, Central¹, South*, and Southwest Arkansas¹
- Closely coordinated with the infant's medical providers and available community resources
